





Northwest Ohio Syringe Services (NOSS)

WHO: We are a collaborative team of healthcare providers from the Toledo-Lucas County Health

Department in conjunction with the UTMC Ryan White Program and the Mental Health and

Recovery Services Board.

WHAT: NOSS promotes public health and safety via non-judgmental syringe exchange, harm reduction

education, and medical and behavioral healthcare referral.

WHEN: Talbot Center- 732 Main St. Toledo, OH 43605

HOW: Participants will be assigned an ID card upon their first visit and will be expected to present this

card upon each return visit to gather data and track individual progress.

WHY: To reduce the number of new HIV, Hepatitis C, and other sexually transmitted infections

Provide multiple locations for the proper disposal of used IV drug using works

- Perform rapid HIV and Hepatitis C testing to persons who inject drugs
- Link persons who are positive for HIV and Hepatitis C to medical care and case management services
- Connect persons of high risk for contracting HIV to PrEP services
- Dispense condoms, other safe sex supplies, and STI educational materials
- Refer for other STI testing and follow up care

To protect the general health of persons who inject drugs

- Discuss safer injection practices during each syringe exchange
- Examine injection sites and refer for additional medical care
- Provide health insurance application
- Refer to general medical/dental and family planning services
- Offer training on how to respond to an overdose with Naloxone
- Dispense Naloxone

To reduce barriers to accessing mental health and substance abuse treatment services

- Refer to social services to help participants meet their basic needs
- Offer sober support meeting schedules
- Build healthy, working relationships with treatment providers and NOSS participants
- Empower persons who inject drugs to make behavioral change
- Provide informed choice for treatment referral
