## Household Sewage Treatment System Repair/Replacement Grant Income Eligibility

Homeowners of a failing household sewage treatment system (HSTS) may qualify for one of the three tiers of funding depending upon the size of their households, and their combined household incomes. The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services 2017 Poverty Guidelines will be used determine the eligibility for the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency Project Year 2018 HSTS Grant which will end **November 30, 2019**.
