**7<sup>th</sup> Grade** Requirements: Tdap and Meningitis  
**12<sup>th</sup> Grade** Requirements: Meningitis (given between ages 16 – 18 years)  
 HPV Vaccine: Only 2 doses needed if started at ages 11 – 14. 3 doses needed if started at 15 years or later. HPV protects against cervical cancer in girls and genital warts in boys.
