1. Presentation:

- Healthy Community presented by the Advocates of Healthy Athletes
 - O In summary Advocates for Healthy Athletes is a collaboration between the University of Toledo and Lucas County Board of DD to give Special Olympics athletes an opportunity to stay fit through a 6-week program that is being offered at no cost. See slides.

2. 2019

- 2019 Workplan
 - i. In the area of Healthy Eating CHC is working to complete 3 projects
 - In Central City Toledo, CHC is working with the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department and an organization in East Toledo to plan and facilitate a pop-up farmer's market at each location to help increase WIC farmer's market coupon redemption. The wet weather has pushed planning back a little but official times and dates will hopefully be scheduled soon.
 - In Central City Toledo CHC is working with WIC's lactation consultant on a lactation support policy with Toledo Hospital. An identified room will be furnished, along with a Lactation Support Policy adopted. Next steps will be to take measurements of the room and begin ordering supplies, while working with administration on a draft policy.
 - In South Toledo CHC is working with Live Well Greater Toledo to link a local farmer with a local South Toledo corner store. At this point both a local farmer and a local corner store have been identified. Next steps include working out the details that will meet the needs of the farmer and the corner store.
 - **ii.** In the area of Active Living CHC is working to complete 3 projects
 - In Lucas County CHC is working with Live Well Greater Toledo to improve Active Transportation in Lucas County through educating stakeholders on the importance of creating an Active Transportation Plan as well as updating current policies to allow for more bike friendly and walk friendly environments.



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- In Central City Toledo CHC is working with the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department on an Active Commute Policy to help allow employees and visitors more access to biking and walking during the workday.
- In South Toledo we are looking to identify another workplace to adopt an Active Commute Policy. This is still in the planning phase.
- iii. In the area of Tobacco Prevention, CHC will be working with a Lucas County jurisdiction on adopting a Tobacco 21 Policy.

- Melissa Hallenbeck (Child and Maternal Health):
 - Opportunities exist to work with worksites who are interested in lactation support. The only requirements are that the worksite be in Lucas County and have 50 employees or less.
 - The Grandparent Project is being rolled out at the Eleanor Kahle Senior Center to help educate grandparents on strategies to help raise grandchildren. See flyer.
- Buckeye Health Plan
 - Buckeye Health would like to work with the CHC program's pop-up farmer's markets connecting Buckeye Health Plan members to these markets while provide an additional \$10 to purchase produce at these sites.

- Live Well Greater Toledo/Safe Routes to School
 - Safe Routes to School was awarded funding through Ohio Department of Transportation for planning and implementation of a School Travel Plan for Washington Local School District. This plan will allow for more infrastructure and non-infrastructure funding to improve safer routes to school throughout the district. Work has already begun with surveying parents to identify issues.

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- TMACOG will begin more Active Transportation trainings beginning June 27th from noon-4pm focusing on traffic calming and complete streets. A walk audit workshop will also take place in August, location and date TBD.

 - The state Dairy Association is continuing to support the School Breakfast Program for schools.
