Starting Friday, September 16, 2016, the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department will begin accepting applications for lead inspectors, risk assessors, and clearance technicians who are currently licensed in the State of Ohio.

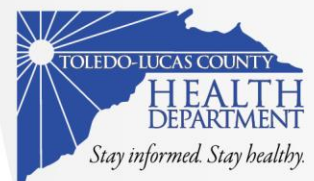
This is **NOT** an application for employment with the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department. You will be listed as a Local Lead Inspector for rental property owners or in-home daycares to contact who require inspections due to the City of Toledo Lead Ordinance.

- The registration fee is \$45
- You will need to provide your ODH license number on the application for verification before it is accepted
