Welcome & Introductions

- Safa Ibrahim of the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department, Tobacco Prevention and Cessation Program greeted all the attendees.

Steering Committee Update-MAPP Process

- Silvia Fofrich of the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department Community Cessation Initiative provided an update on the first steering committee meeting that occurred on December 4, 2018.
- Fourteen individuals attended the first steering committee meeting. Brandon Palinski, The Quality Assurance and Accreditation Coordinator at the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department presented about a process called MAPP: Mobilizing for Action through Planning and Partnership. This process focuses on improving community health and will help us create a strong and successful coalition. The steering committee has worked through phase 1 and will continue to focus on this process.

CHIP Updates

- Safa Ibrahim presented an update on the Community Health Improvement Plan in regards to tobacco prevention (*See presentation slides*)
- Donna Fox presented an update on the Community Health Improvement Plan in regards to cessation (*See presentation slides*)

Breakout sessions with subgroups

- Safa Ibrahim reminded the group of the sub-committees that were formed during the previous meeting (Tobacco Cessation, Infant Mortality, State Level Tobacco Policy Change and Youth Tobacco Prevention Efforts) and discussed expectations for each group, such as exchanging contact information and setting up meetings outside of the regular quarterly meetings to work on sub-committee goals and objectives.
- The sub-committees were instructed to review the goals that were established during the first meeting and to work on the SMART goal worksheet that was provided.

Member Updates

- Cindi Pisano from Mercy Health discussed the Mom's Quit for Two (Baby and Me program). It is a tobacco cessation program offered through Mercy Health to help pregnant women quit smoking. The program provides incentives to encourage women to stay tobacco free. Baby and Me has partnered with the Community Cessation Initiative to provide cessation services for pregnant women.
