

Household Sewage Treatment System Operation and Maintenance Program Informational Meetings

The Toledo-Lucas County Health Department will hold two community meetings to discuss the Operation and Maintenance Program for Household Sewage Treatment Systems. Lucas County has roughly 15,000 homes that maintain a Household Sewage Treatment System (septic system) on their property. A sewage treatment system or “septic system” means the home or business is not connected to the sanitary sewer and will treat waste with a system that is contained on the property.

Attendees will learn how the Household Sewage Treatment System Operation and Maintenance Program will be phased in throughout Lucas County, and how they can properly maintain their septic system. Inspectors from the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department Environmental Health Division will be available to answer questions regarding household sewage system maintenance.

The meetings are open to all Lucas County residents who maintain a household sewage treatment system on their property and to all septic contractors working in Lucas County.
