This position is responsible for assisting in the management and implementation of Getting to 1 the Toledo-Lucas County Ohio Equity Institute team. The position serves as a leader to the Getting to 1 Coalition. Under supervision of the Supervisor of Maternal & Child Health, the incumbent exercises judgment and discretion in meeting program objectives.

Basic Qualifications:

- Excellent written & verbal communication, analytical & investigative, and organizational & detail-oriented skills
- Ability to work with diverse populations
- Ability to work independently and as a member of an inter-disciplinary team
- A valid driver's license and reliable transportation

- Master’s Degree in Public Health/related field
- Documented experience in public health, 1-3 years in maternal/child health
- Grant writing and reporting experience

Responsibilities:

Facilitates OEI upstream and downstream intervention implementation.
Submits OEI community team list as updated including community meeting minutes/notes.
Submits data to OEI Epidemiologist for ODSS, tracking and reporting outcomes in ODSS, especially in census tracts previously identified with poor birth outcomes and as otherwise prescribed by the Ohio Department of Health.
Submits monthly program reports that outline progress in implementing interventions overall and within census geographies previously identified as having a high burden of low birthweight and premature birth outcomes.
Submits a mid-year and annual data report using ODSS data and graphics and supplemented by other data a described in the evaluation plan.
Update OEI Logic Models and OEI Evaluation Plans submitted with mid-year and annual report.
Participate in monthly OEI technical assistance calls and Learning Community opportunities with the Ohio Department of Health.
Attend yearly face to face OEI meetings.
Assures entry and collection of data for ODSS from partners.
Responsible for all OEI core team meetings

Other Duties & Responsibilities: Represents the Health Department at a variety of meetings in the community. Other duties as assigned.
