



**Position: Maternal Mortality Clinician**

The Toledo-Lucas County Health Department seeks a Nurse, Certified Nurse Practitioner, Certified Nurse Midwife, or Certified Physician Assistant to serve as our Maternal Mortality Clinician, whose purpose is to provide direct care services to pregnant and postpartum Healthy Start participants. Visits may occur in the home, office or virtually. The purpose of the visits will be to identify any health concerns, to provide preventative care and/or to provide information regarding maternal early warning signs and postpartum warning signs. In addition to direct care, the Maternal Mortality Clinician is also expected to conduct trainings with internal Healthy Start staff and to provide community presentations to increase awareness among stakeholders and community members about maternal early warning signs, postpartum warning signs, and maternal death.

**Basic Qualifications:**

- Appropriate educational level required in area of specialty (Nurse Required; Nurse Practitioner, Nurse Midwife, or Physician Assistant Preferred).
- Current, active and unrestricted license in the State of Ohio
- Current certification in the area of specialty
- Current BLS certification.
- Minimum 1 year clinical experience in reproductive health in a women's health or family practice setting.
- Knowledge of and ability to conduct services following generally recognized standards of care for advanced practice medical practitioners.
- Carry professional liability insurance, appropriate to the services being rendered.

**Responsibilities:**

The Maternal Mortality Clinician agrees to provide services as a 1099 Contractor, and can expect:

- Part-time/irregular and/or non-traditional hours, with scheduled visits to be based on the mutual availability of the Healthy Start participants and the Maternal Mortality Clinician. Can expect to see 100 participants over the course of one calendar year.
- A minimum of one visit is required per participant, with follow-up visits as deemed clinically necessary, with case notes documented in real time.
- Compensation is on a flat fee schedule per participant, and is payable upon documentation of the initial visit within our Well Family system.
- The Maternal Mortality Clinician shall be provided with the supplies and equipment needed for the physical assessment(s) (stethoscope, fetal heart tone monitor, blood pressure cuff, thermometer, etc) as well as all computer and internet related equipment in order to access required systems to submit documentation.
