

Lucas County Quarantine Guidance

The Toledo-Lucas County Health Department **strongly recommends unvaccinated individuals exposed to a COVID-19 positive person to quarantine for fourteen (14) days** from the date of the last exposure (day zero). **Individuals are required to quarantine for a minimum of ten (10) days** and monitor for symptoms through day fourteen (14).

In accordance with the CDC's updated guidance, the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department recognizes the following quarantine options:

★ Gold Standard Quarantine	Alternative Quarantine	Isolation Period
<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Unvaccinated individuals exposed to COVID-19 should quarantine at home for 14 days from the date of exposure (day zero).➤ Lowest Risk of spreading COVID-19.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Unvaccinated individuals exposed to COVID-19 are required to quarantine at home through day 10 from the last date of exposure (day zero) and monitor for symptoms through day 14.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Any individual showing signs or symptoms of COVID-19 should isolate at home for 10 days from symptom start or test date (day zero).➤ Isolation period is independent from any time spent in quarantine.

***Vaccinated individuals exposed to a COVID-19 positive person do not need to quarantine but should monitor for symptoms for 14 days.**

***Any individual developing symptoms should immediately isolate and get a COVID-19 test.**
