Abbott BinaxNOW COVID-19 Rapid Test Kit Procedures

IMPORTANT: If you are taking the test for use in reducing quarantine after exposure, or you need an official result for work, travel, or a social event that requires testing, complete the proctored test steps.

BEFORE TAKING THE TEST (Proctored)

Do Not Open Test Kit Until Instructed to Do So

- 1. Before taking your test, download the Navica app on your smart device or visit https://www.mynavica.abbott/.

- **2.** Create an account or login if you already have one.
- 3. Next go to https://ohio.emed.com/ on your smart device or a computer with a camera and click **Start Testing**. You will be asked to login with your Navica account.
- 4. Complete the checklist on eMed's website to be placed in a virtual waiting room to be joined by a certified proctor.

TAKING THE TEST


- **6.** It is recommended you wash your hands before taking the test
- 7. Follow the steps below and the proctor's instructions if completing a proctor session:
 - **a.** Lay card on a flat surface and avoid touching inside parts or moving the card around.
 - **b.** Add 6 drops from the dropper to the top hole in the test card.
 - c. Remove Swab from package and insert up to 3/4^{ths} of an inch into your right nostril.
 - **d.** Firmly brush against inside of nostril in a circular motion 5 times or more for 15 seconds.
 - e. Repeat in left nostril.
 - f. Insert swab in bottom hole and firmly push up until tip fills the top hole. Turn swab 3 times and leave in place.
 - g. Peel adhesive liner off card and close left side of the card over the swab to seal it.



TEST RESULTS

8. Positive Results: Two pink/purple lines will appear. One on the top half and one on the bottom half. **COVID-19 was detected.** Isolate for 10 days and avoid family gatherings.




Here are photos of actual positive tests. On the right, note how faint the bottom line can get.



Negative Results: A single pink/purple line on the top half where it says "Control." COVID-19 was not detected.

Negative results may require additional molecular (PCR) testing to confirm that you do not have COVID-19, especially if you are symptomatic.



10. Invalid Results: If you see any of the results below, the test is invalid. Recommend a follow-up test or consultation with your physician. If you have COVID-like symptoms isolate away from others until you can obtain another test.
