I. Call to Order and Roll Call

IV. Approval of Board Minutes from September 23, 2021

The September 23, 2021 Board Minutes were presented for approval.

(Resolution 2021.10.143) Motion was made by Paul Komisarek and seconded by Dr. Fernandez to approve the minutes of the September 23, 2021 Board Meeting. Motion carried, 9 Yeas, 0 Nays.

V. Public Hearing and 3rd Reading for the Proposed 2022 Environmental Health Fees

The Hearing was opened by Donald Murray. The third reading proposed fees were presented for consideration. There were no changes from the previous two readings. Mr. Murray asked if there was anyone from the public who wanted to make comments on the fees. Mr. Jeffrey Lublin questioned the increase of the semi-public fee. He stated that the office is rarely used and there is very little flow. David Welch will meet with Mr. Lublin regarding his system. Mr. Murray asked three times if there were any other comments regarding the proposed fees. There were no additional comments. The public comment section was closed by Mr. Murray. A request for a motion was made.

(Resolution 2021.10.144) A motion was made by Dr. Munk and seconded by Paul Komisarek to approve the 2022 fees as presented. Roll Call vote was taken. Motion Carried. 10 Yeas, 0 Nays (see attached roll call vote sheet).

VI. Legal Update – Kevin Pituch

Mr. Pituch reported that the lawsuit filed against Eric Zgodzinski by the Dance Studios regarding cancellation of their competition due to COVID-19 had been dismissed by the courts.

VII. Medical Director's Report

Dr. Daniel Cadigan reported on the activities for the month.

- COVID Vaccine booster clinics are now being held for Pfizer, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines.
- Minority cancer access to care and treatment is being discussed for minority groups, women, and the LBGQT community. Promedica had a similar program in place a few years back for high blood pressure issues. We have programs within the health department that we can tie into this program.
- The SAMPRA asthma education and treatment in schools program. The state allows us to provide Epi pens and nebulizers in the schools. This program will be piloted at one or two schools during the second part of the school year.
- Clinic staff has been working on policies and procedures.
- Policy on lab results being made available on the patient portal is being completed. This is in regards to the Twentieth Century Cures Act allows patients to have immediate access to their information.
- The Physicians' referral list for reproductive health clinics has been updated for the NPs to use for referrals.
- Epi Pen for schools program renewal has been completed for Toledo Public Schools.
- Looking at screening, and treatment components. There are some free or low cost programs for MRI's and screenings in the community. We will be talking to the hospitals to get the screening trailers into some of the communities. The most up to date study was by the State of North Carolina regarding chronic diseases as related to disparities and poverty in Ohio is from 2018 and lists the 10 richest and poorest counties in Ohio. Lucas County was one of the poorest counties on the list. Testing is a huge thing for early detection.

VIII. Executive Session

Dr. Ross reported that there were no decisions made during the Executive Session.

IX. Audit/Finance Committee Report – Ted Kaczorowski

The Audit/Finance Committee met on Monday, October 26, 2021.

1. Payment of the September 2021 Vouchers

Tina Stokes has added asterisks on the bill schedule on any items that needed approval from the Chair of the Committee prior to being presented at the board meeting. There were two from the month of October. One was Cash Star and the other was SRFax.

(Resolution 2021.10.147) A motion was made by Dr. Fernandez and seconded by Dr. Munk to approve the payment of the July, 2021 vouchers. Motion carried, 10 Yeas, 0 Nays.

2. Transfer of Appropriations

A transfer reallocates funds from one cost object to another. Board of Health Resolution is required to approve Transfers of Appropriations performed in the month of September, 2021 in the ordinary course of business. Total transfer is \$5,510.00 consisting of changes in various expense categories.

(Resolution 2021.10.148) A motion was made by Paul Komisarek and seconded by Dr. Woodson to approve the Transfer of Appropriations of \$5,510.00. Motion carried, 10 Yeas, 0 Nays.

3. Revenue Estimates and Expense Appropriations:

Board of Health Resolution is required to approve changes in Revenue Estimates and Expense Appropriations for the month of September 2021 in the amount of \$2,898,337.00

(Resolution 2021.10.149) A motion was made Susan Postal and seconded by Dr. Fernandez to approve the Revenue Estimates and Expense Appropriations of \$2,898.337.00. Motion carried, 10 Yeas, 0 Nays.

4. Write off of uncollectable billing:

The write-off of uncollectable revenue for the self-pay patient's portion of the bills for the month of September is \$4,472.72 for the month of September. There will be a report provided at each board meeting with the amount of revenue that is written off.

Future reports will include a summary sheet which is a simplified list of those items that are of importance. You will also receive a sheet that will include the grants to better track where we are with each grant. This will be used in the general revenue funds.

X. Personnel Committee Report – Michelle Schultz

The Personnel Committee met on Monday, September 20, 2021.

1. The Personnel Committee discussed and recommended the appointment of Angelina Bauman to the classified full-time permanent position of Clinical & Outreach Supervisor in the non-bargaining unit, at the rate of pay of \$32.64 per hour.

XVI. Health Commissioner's Comments – Eric Zgodzinski COVID-19 UPDATE:

- Booster shots are now available. We have all three vaccines available. PODs are being held at the Lucas County Rec Center and at TLCHD. There were over 1000 people vaccinated yesterday.
- Infections are coming down in the area and the country. The average was 126 and now down to 99.
- 53.42% of our population are vaccinated with at least the first dose.
- We will be talking to the schools this afternoon to talk about quarantine and isolation and to discuss in-school vaccinations of the 5-12 year olds.
- HB463 is looking to disband DAC and put control under the County Commissioners.

- Take the time to look at the Divisional reports from Health Promotions, Health Services and Environmental Health.
- Molnupiravir drug from Merck is showing about 50% effectiveness in keeping people who are highly vulnerable out of the hospital if they get COVID.
