The Environmental Health Technician will assist in the Storm Water and Household Sewage Treatment System Inspection Programs by conducting field sampling using ArcGIS and Field Maps to locate and record sample results in Lucas County in accordance with the Ohio EPA Findings and Orders, Home Sewage Sanitary Survey Plan, and the Ohio EPA MS4 permit. This is a part-time seasonal job requiring 24-30 hour a week.

Basic Qualifications:

- Must be enrolled in a Bachelor’s degree program in a hard science field. Examples include, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, and Environmental Health.
- Must have the ability to lift 30 lbs.
- Excellent written and verbal communication, analytical and investigative, organizational and detail orient skills.
- Ability to work independently and a member of a team.
- Ability to work with diverse ethnic, cultural and socio-economic groups.
- A valid OH/MI driver’s license and reliable transportation are required.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Entering 3rd year of a Bachelor’s degree program in a hard science field.
- Sampling/science lab experience.

Responsibilities:

Take water samples from catch basins, sewage system sample ports, local streams and waterways.
Conduct field research activities by using Field Maps and ArcGIS to document the locations of the samples.
Assist with the preparation of reports for presentations at professional meetings and for the Home Sewage Sanitary Survey Plan.
Assist the preparation of reports in accordance with the Ohio EPA MS4 permit and the Storm Water Management Program.
Ability to assist with conducting dye testing of household sewage treatment systems.
Attend meetings with the Registered Environmental Health Specialists in the Storm Water Management and Household Sewage Treatment System Inspection Programs.
Maintain records for all samples collected and enter the results into the appropriate databases.
Other duties as assigned to support the Storm Water Management and Household Sewage Treatment System Inspection Programs including HB 110 Sewage Treatment Systems & the Operation & Maintenance Program.

Other Duties & Responsibilities: Represents the Health Department at a variety of meetings in the community.
