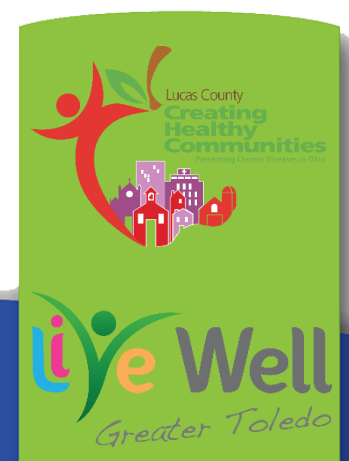

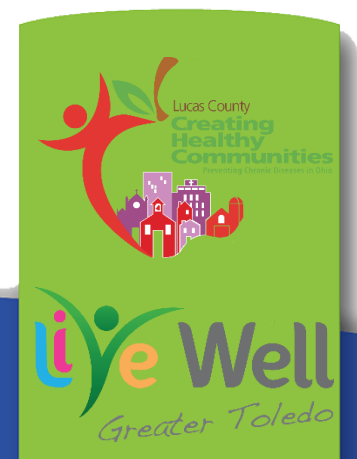

 - i. ODOT WLS Infrastructure - \$390,190 – active – projects to completed 2023
 - ii. Toledo Community Funds – year 2 -\$65,000 – active end December 2022
 - iii. ODOT SRTS – TPS \$60,000 and WLS -\$20,000 – active
 - iv. ODOT TPS Infrastructure - \$243,000 – awarded-2024
 - v. ODOT WLS Infrastructure – \$396,964.64-awarded-2025
 - vi. ODOT WLS Non-Infrastructure – \$20,000-awarded
 - vii. ODOT TPS Non-Infrastructure – \$40,000-awarded
