All facilities will be classified as of January 1, 2024, as a Commercial Level-Small which is less than 25,000 sq. ft., or a Commercial Level-Large, which is over 25,000 sq. ft. To find out which classification your facility is, please refer to the bottom box of your current Food Operations License or Retail Food Establishment License. Starting January 1, 2024, removal of the Non-Commercial classification establishes that all food facilities will be classified the same and pay the same rate according to their risk classification. For example, if your license states your classification is a Non-Commercial Level 1, less than 25,000 sq. ft., your new classification will be Commercial Level 1, less than 25,000 sq. ft.

The Toledo-Lucas County Health Department will be holding a public hearing regarding the adjusted fees on Thursday, December 14, 2023, at The Lucas County Public Library, 325 N. Michigan Street, Toledo, Ohio at 8:45 A.M. in the Large Glass Conference Room on the first floor. Enter via the parking garage on Adams Street.
