Health Department Conducts Mock Crash Event At Clay High School

The Toledo-Lucas County Health Department, along with several partnering agencies, are coordinating a mock crash event at Clay High School on April 17. The event will serve as a hard-hitting reminder to students and parents of the dangers and consequences of unsafe driving behaviors-such as drinking and driving, driving while distracted, driving at unsafe speeds, and not buckling up.

- WHO: Toledo-Lucas County Health Department Oregon Fire and EMS Oregon Police Rau's Towing UTMC Trauma Team
- **WHAT:** The mock crash uses real crashed vehicles set up on school grounds and students participate to act out roles as crash victims. Students will watch the demonstration of a simulated 911 call, emergency response efforts including the ProMedica air ambulance, a mock memorial, and a mock trial.
- WHEN: Wednesday, April 17, 2024 Mock Crash: 8:30 to 9:10 a.m. Mock Trial: 9:15 to 9:40 a.m. *If necessary, rain date: Friday, April 19, 2024*
