


2. 2023 Data Updates

TLCHD:

- Brief presentation on 2023 overdose fatality review, including demographics and zip code trends (data sheet provided in meeting follow up email)
- Naloxone distribution data over 18 month period included. Highlights include that a high percentage of people receiving Narcan have used drugs before or seen an overdose. Naloxone is also being equitably distributed according to the demographics through over 24 diverse county programs.
- Goal for the group: Consider how we can utilize this data to increase presence of resources in at risk zip codes (43612 a key example)

3. 211 Presentation, Emily Matthews (ematthews@211toledo.org)

- 211 is a national effort, not just a Toledo resource.
- Services: connection to housing, food, clothes, holiday baskets, tax appointments, diapers, baby formula, veteran services, etc. They have a translation line for non-English speakers.
- Agencies that provide services should reach out as needed to update their info as it changes to ensure callers receive correct info.
- United Way can market services on an agency's behalf and are always looking to promote more sober living options.
- 211 Staff are eager to learn more about SUD resources available and how to better communicate with folks who are struggling when they have encounters.
- 211 staff meet on the 4th Thursday of month 4 6pm and they are interested in collaboration and trainings in mental health / SUD. Calendar open for 2025.
